LOOK

What do you see in this painting? Find lots of colors (red, blue, yellow, orange, purple and green) in the shape of a bathrobe. What is a bathrobe? It is something you wear after you take a bath. Do you like to play with any toys in the bathtub? Do you have a rubber ducky?

Practice counting with this poem about ducks:

5 little ducks went out one day, over the hills and far away,
Mother duck said Quack! Quack! Quack!
But only 4 little ducks came waddling back.

Repeat with 4, 3, 2, 1...

No little ducks went out one day, over the hills and far away,
Mother duck said Quack! Quack! Quack!
And all 5 little ducks came waddling back!

READ

Bath! Bath! Bath! By Douglas Florian and illustrated by Christiane Engel is a fun rhyming story about taking a bath to get clean after a fun day of playing. If you don't have this book, find another book about bath time, or handwashing take a few minutes to read.

MAKE
