


Museum Stories December 30, 2020

This week, Museum Stories highlights bright lights in the museum and twinkling lights in the sky. Take a few minutes to watch the short video.

LOOK

This artwork, called *Dots*, by South Korean artist Chuyl Hyun Ahn is made of colorful circles. How many circles can you count? What colors do you see? *Dots* is a shadow box. It a shallow container with tubes of lights that change colors. There is a mirror behind the lights. The mirror and lights make it seem like the dots are moving through space.

READ

This week, the recommended book is the always favorite, *Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star*, illustrated by Yu-hsuan Huang. The dots in the shadowbox artwork of Chul Hyun Ahn glow and vibrate with brightness like the starts in the sky. This version of the book, with pop-up features, will be a fun sing-along moment for all.
