

SUMMER ART CAMP COUNSELOR

Summer Art Camp Counselors are responsible for assisting Camp Instructors in the studios and periodic supervision of campers. This position is designed as a seasonal 40 hour/week, 8-week appointment.

Hourly Wage \$10.00/hr

Responsibilities:

- Assist instructors and actively participate in all aspects of the campers' day.
- Guide campers in participating successfully in all aspects of camp activities.
- Assist Camp Coordinator with supervising snack and bathroom breaks.
- Assist docent tours and demonstrate appropriate gallery behavior.
- Recognize and respond to opportunities for group problem solving.
- Encourage respect for camper projects, camp materials and facilities.
- Set a good example for campers in all areas, including clean-up chores, rules, and safety.
- Submit all required paperwork on time.
- Respect no cell phone usage protocol except on breaks.

Functional Relationships:

Reports to the Museum Art School Manager and the Summer Art Camp Coordinator. **Works closely with** the Summer Art Camp Coordinator, MAS Registrar, MAS Manager, Director of Education, and all Summer Art Camp faculty and volunteers.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Pass a Florida state Level II background screening.
- Good customer service skills; positive, helpful attitude for parents, children, staff.
- Experience as a camp counselor or camp volunteer preferred.
- Desire to work in a cooperative, team-oriented atmosphere.
- Enthusiasm, patience and self-control.
