# **Required Materials**

- canvas; stretched; primed or unprimed; 1 canvas; no smaller than 11" X 14"
- water color paper/heavyweight drawing paper (93#); 30 sheets; 6" X 6"
- watercolor paper; 300# cold press; 1 sheet: 22" X 30"
- cradled panel; primed or unprimed; 1 panel; no smaller than 11" X 14"
- acrylic medium; 32 oz.
- gesso; 32 oz.
- scissors
- water container
- butcher tray(s)
- paper towels
- artist apron/smock
- plastic/disposable gloves
- paint brushes, assorted
- trowel
- brayer
- exacto knife
- tape (preferably white)
- collage material\*\*
