It has been my honor and privilege to serve as your Steering Committee Chair for the past two seasons. Together, we have accomplished so much!

I'm thrilled to announce that at our Closing Reception on April 11th, we raised enough to fully fund our top three program selections! We introduced a new voting system that allowed members to vote for multiple programs in ranked order, and after funding our first three selections, we had enough funds left to partially fund a fourth! You'll find a listing of the programs selected in the "Program Observations" section below, and the exact amounts funded in the "Finance" section. Our accomplishments of the 2023-2024 Season:

- Welcomed more than 40 new members
- Increased our sustained financial impact by 20+ percent
- Set record attendance at our meetings and special events
- Revamped our Program Observation process and implemented a new voting system
- Developed a Finance Committee to ensure our financial health as we grow
- Fully funded three programs and partially funded a 4th
- Published six comprehensive newsletters and expanded our website
- Provided seven member-only events
- Introduced alternative paths for directed giving
- Established an Executive Committee to guide us into the future

We will continue to grow our support of the VBMA educational programs that touch our hearts, and provide our community with the profound educational, emotional, and healing benefits that access to art provides. # **Program Observation Teams**

On April 11th, the overflowing Atrium at the VBMA buzzed with energy and excitement as our members assembled to hear about the goals, history, structure and budget of each of the programs under consideration for funding. The choices presented were: Veterans Program, Senior Resource Association Partnership, Pre-K at the VBMA!, Family Programs, and Alzheimer & Parkinson Association Partnership. These were very difficult choices as all of these programs positively enrich the lives of our community.

This year, a new voting system was introduced, allowing each member to vote for three programs in ranked order. Since the funding for this season increased by

In April of 2015, members of The Circle voted to support the VBMA's collaboration with The Learning Alliance's "Moonshot Moment" initiative, the goal of which was to have 90% of third-grade students reading at grade level by 2018. The Circle's support enabled teachers from every elementary school and parents from five kindergarten readiness centers to integrate visual arts into the curriculum supporting student literacy.
