

BEGINNING OIL PAINTING – MATERIALS LIST

- 32 oz. can of Gamsol or Turpenoid (NOT Turpenoid Natural)
- Paper palettes, grey tones, disposable, at least 11" x 15"
- Simply Simmons chungking hog-bristle brushes for oil painting, (Bright) 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 (Find at DickBlick.com)
- Palette knife: Blick Palette Knife RGM, style 13
- Palette knife: Blick Palette Knife RGM, style 22
- Artists panels, 12 x 16, one for each class
- Metal brush cleaner. Two containers are great to have. Recommend Holbein Portable Brush Washer.

Paints:

- M. Graham & Co.: Titanium White: 5 fluid oz.

Also paint colors, all 37. ml:

- Utrecht:
 - Ivory Black
 - Cadmium yellow lemon pure
 - Winsor blue – also called Phthalo Blue
 - Brilliant blue
- Rembrandt:
 - Permanent red medium
 - Sevres blue
 - Cold grey
 - Warm gray
- Holbein: Grey of Grey, 37 ml.
- Winsor & Newton
 - Indian yellow
 - Permanent rose
- Gambin: Phthalo turquoise

Also:

- Clear plastic 16" ruler
- Gloves, NON-LATEX Ambitex (surgical supply store)
- Apron or long shirt – to protect clothing
- Plastic container
- Small sketchbook, pencil and pen
- Rags – hand towels
- Paper towels
- Unscented baby wipes – large box of wipes at Publix
- 2 clothes pins or other clips
- Mason jar (Dollar store)
- A roll of scotch tape
- Q-tips
