One of the top record producers of the 1960s and 1970s, Simon was responsible for pulling together more than a dozen albums now considered classics, including The Band's Music from Big Pink, The Band, and The Last Waltz, Cheap Thrills by Big Brother & the Holding Company featuring Janis Joplin, Songs of Leonard Cohen by Leonard Cohen, and Child Is Father to the Man by Blood, Sweat & Tears, and other recordings from Simon & Garfunkel, Gordon Lightfoot, Mama Cass Elliot, David Sanborn, Gil Evans and Michael Franks, among others.

The Songwriter

Though known principally for his successes as a record producer, Simon has always been a songwriter, and has recorded critically-acclaimed albums for Warner Brothers, Vanguard and several labels abroad. He has recently embarked on a program of public appearances in concert halls, colleges, clubs, libraries and arts organizations.

The Storyteller


John is equally comfortable playing his songs, telling tales of life inside the recording studio, or engaging in a O&A with the audience.


