Student Grade Acrylic paints in these colors (Tubes or Bottled):

*Although these may be purchased at Michael's it is less expensive to purchase paints ON LINE, through Amazon or Cheap Joes

Ultramarine Blue OR Cobalt Blue

Cobalt Violet OR Dioxazine purple

Permanent Green (or ANY Dark green EXCEPT PHTHALO GREEN)

Cadmium Yellow

Cadmium Red

Alizarin Crimson Red

Titanium White

Black

2 - 4 Small "Student Grade" Acrylic paint brushes (These sometimes come in packages as beginner's sets of brushes in several sizes and shapes. You should be able to purchase these at Michael's inexpensively)

1 Large Package of CARD STOCK COLORED PAPER - with at least 15 colors!

Mixed Media Drawing pad - size 11" x 14" OR LARGER!!!!!! - Paper must be suitable for use with acrylic paints

White foam core dinner plates (for use as a painting palette)

Small Plastic container for water

1 Small Roll of PAPER TOWELS

Small water mist bottle (to keep paints moist)

12" Ruler or T-Square

several #2 pencils and an eraser

1 Sharp pair of Scissors

Glue Sticks OR 1 small bottle of Elmer's Glue

Graphite TRANSFER PAPER (found at Michaels in small cellophane package)

Box of Crayola Crayons OR Set of Colored Pencils (you may purchase both if desired)

Colored Markers are also useful but NOT A NECESSITY!

2 - 3 Large/Small zip loc bags
