Medium:

100% odorless mineral spirits (Gamsol or the Mona Lisa Brand)

Brushes:

Preferably synthetic - not bristle brushes. **Recommended Brand**: Creative Mark Ebony Splendor filberts and flats sizes 2-8. The more brushes the better, and have about 5 tiny ones, too, with nice points.

Other:

Palette (wood or grey paper, NOT white)

Palette knife Creative Mark T27 or similar shape

Acetate Pad or Sheet cut into a 5x7" shape

2 Brush Holders (one for clean brushes, one for dirty brushes)

Stiff Board for reference and panel to attach to side by side (approx., 16x20")

Artist's Tape

Clamps (2)

Viewfinder or Viewcatcher (optional)

Paper Towels

2 glass jars with lids (one for clean Mineral Spirits and one for Brush Cleaning)
