10 SESSION COURSE

This list is useful as a guide to refresh your supplies and materials. Select whether you are working in oils  
OR acrylics. Supply list:

For OILS -	For ACRYLICS -
Brushes (1 each): #10 flat #6 flat #2 flat #6 round sable or synthetic round Angle Shader liner or stripper Hake(or similar)blending brush 3" utility brush  Paper palette pad Canvas pads or canvas board (12x16 minimum) Odorless Turpenoid Linseed oil Metal cups for solvents Palette knife (plastic is fine) Rags Sketch pad/Newsprint pad Sketching implements of choice (pencil, charcoal, etc.) Paints (see below)	Brushes (1 each): #10 flat #6 flat #2 flat #6 round sable or synthetic round Angle Shader liner or stripper Hake(or similar)blending brush 3" utility brush  Paper palette pad Canvas pads or canvas board (12x16 minimum) 2 plastic water containers Rags Sketch pad/Newsprint pad Palette knife (plastic is fine) Sketching implements of choice (pencil, charcoal, etc.) Paints (see below)
