- Watercolor paper (minimum in size of 9 inches x 12 inches. I prefer Hot Press to Cold Press. I love Arches brand but it is the most expensive. Canson and other brands are fine too.
 - Watercolor brushes (fine tip and medium tip). As long as you are comfortable holding it and using it, it doesn't matter what brand.
 - Watercolor paints in tubes. Any quality brand.
 - Palette Color Basics. Colors with * are a must, the others are suggested. I love experimenting with new colors, and with different brands, so feel free to bring a wide rainbow of colors.
 - Lemon Yellow *
 - Aureolin
 - Cobalt Blue *
 - French Ultramarine
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Vermillion Red
 - Rose Madder/Permanent Rose *
 - Raw Sienna *
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Viridian Green
 - Paynes Grey *

- Graphite pencils – Ebony drawing pencil would also be ideal
 - Small pencil sharpener
 - Watercolor pencils and/or watercolor pastels/watercolor crayons
 - White gouache (an opaque watercolor paint)
