

WATERCOLOR MAGIC

Please provide a materials list for your course:

Due to the COST OF PROFESSIONAL GRADE PAINTS, Paper and Brushes needed for this class, I HIGHLY RECOMMEND that students who do not already have their supplies, purchase them on line.

PLEASE, PLEASE send along the materials list as far in ADVANCE AS POSSIBLE to all students. They will need these supplies for the first class. I recommend purchasing supplies from www.CheapJoes.com, AMAZON.com, Dick Blick or Jerry's.

Plastic Water Bucket or Container Spray Mister Bottle for Water Paper Towels and a SMALL PACKET OF Facial Tissues Pencil and Eraser (#2 pencil is fine) 1 small roll of PAINTER's BLUE TAPE

A watercolor BOARD, this can be made from two pieces of foam core taped together in a size which is appropriate to paper

WATERCOLOR PALETTE WITH LID, with at least 16 color wells, I RECOMMEND the Robert E. Wood palette, which can be purchased from www.CheapJoes.com

Professional Grade Watercolor Brushes (variety of "rounds", "flats", 2"- 3" WASH, a "rigger" or fine line detail brush)
Synthetic brushes are fine, but they should be good quality brushes. Robert Simmons brand brushes are usually nice.
Professional Grade Watercolor Paper (Preferably in BLOCK FORM) 300 lb. is preferred but in block form, you may use 140 lb paper
OR

Professional Grade Watercolor Paper in FULL SHEETS, but it must be 200-300 lb. paper

Professional Grade Paints in these colors: (color names will vary according to manufacturer): STUDENTS SHOULD DEFINITELY USE PROFESSIONAL GRADE Paints!!!! These manufacturers are fine: Rembrant, Grumbacher Finest Artist's Watercolors, Daniel Smith, Windsor Newton, Holbein, and I personally use the Cheap Joes, brand, "American Journey" watercolor paints

Lemon Yellow
Cadmium Yellow
Alizarin Crimson
Cadmium Red
Cerulean Blue
Cobalt Blue and/or Ultramarine Blue
Phthalo Blue
Viridian Green
Hooker's Green
Dioxadine Violet
Permanent Rose or Opera (basically any bright transparent PINK will do)
Titanium White
Lamo Black

Also, you may purchase any other colors you may like to use in the "brown's" family or other greens, oranges, purples
