This is my selection of brushes, bring the brushes that you have as long as you have a variety of sizes and styles.

## Brushes and Tools

- **A variety of brushes: flat, round, filbert, fan**
- **1" and 2" color shapers**
- **Chip Brushes 1/2", 1", 2" (Micheal's) or [Amazon](#)**
- **FoamBrushes 1/2", 1" (Micheal's) [Amazon](#)**
- **KitchenSponge natural [HERE](#) Cut one sponge in 2 pieces so you will have 2 large and 2 small.**
- **Long Rigger Brush**
- **Palette Knives, trowel type, a small and one larger (I like the cheap plastic ones)**
- **Small brayer (2") or sponge rollers [Amazon](#)**

## Drawingtools

- **6B Pencil**
- **Eraser**
- **Sharpeneter**

## Substrates

*You will need 2 substrates. (Micheals, Jerry's or Hobby Lobby)*

- **1 Canvas 12x16" or 16"X16" or 16 X 20" for the floral project (2 canvases if you paint fast)**
- **1 Canvas 16" X 20" or 20" x 20" for the seascape Project (2 canvases if you paint fast)**
- **Synthetic Multimedia paper 9 x12 (See Jerry's link at the top)**
- **Synthetic Multimedia paper 5 x 7**

## Acrylic Paint

**BASICPAINT COLORS Heavy body or fluid are OK or a mixture of both (no student grade please!)**

- Phthalo **blue/green** Shade
- Ultramarine Blue
- Alizarin Crimson or Quinacridone Magenta
- Fluorescent Pink by Golden or Luminous Opera by Holbein
- Indian Yellow (Warm yellow)
- Yellow Light or Hansa (Cool yellow)
- Black (Mars or Carbon black)
- **A large** tube of Titanium white
- Satin Glazing Liquid medium

## ALSO additional items:

- **Palette paper (16x12)**
- **Smooth Viva paper towel**
- **Spray bottle**
- **Small bucket for water**
- **Apron**
- **Masking Tape [HERE](#)**
- **1 piece of cardboard 12X16" (backing of a pad or pizza box are great, not the corrugated ones)**
