Michael Telesmanick, multi-instrumentalist (piano, keyboard, bass, drums, guitar, vibes and percussion), composer, producer, arranger, sound designer, vocalist, and Graduate Cum Laude from the re-known Berklee College of Music in Boston, is humbly known to his colleagues and friends as simply, "T", or "Mike T", but Michael's prowess on the ivories and his immense knowledge of music and jazz history is anything but simple.

The esteemed Conductor of the Boston Pops Symphony Orchestra and revered Academy Award winning American Film Composer, John Williams (Star Wars, Jaws, E.T., Jurassic Park, Schindler's list and virtually all of Steven Spielberg's films) hand-delivered Mike his degree from Berklee College of Music, along with drummer, Buddy Rich, who personally acknowledged Mike's outstanding talent as a jazz pianist. From that day forward, Mike has honored his mentors in various capacities by composing, performing and recording for the past 25 years throughout the US and abroad with his own band, as well as playing with many established award-winning artists, including the following:

In the mid 1990's, Mike recorded his critically acclaimed CD, "*Illumination*", in Chick Corea's "*Madhatter Studios*" in Los Angeles, CA. Mike was a regular invite to sit in with jazz icons playing in the LA area at that time: drummers, Jeff Tain Watts and Willie Jones, III; pianists Brad Mehldau and Kenny Kirkland; and saxophonist, Branford Marsalis. Mike was the principal pianist performing weekly at the *World Stage* in Leimert Park, oftentimes with Billy Higgins (the most recorded drummer in Jazz history, who played with John Coltrane, Dexter Gordon, Herbie Hancock, Milt Jackson, Charles Lloyd, Pat Metheny, Lee Morgan, Cedar Walton, Charlie Hayden, and Ornette Coleman). Playing regularly in Los Angeles jazz venues, *Catalina Bar & Grill*, the *Jazz Bakery*, the *Baked Potato, Chadney's*, *Atlas Bar & Grill, Rocco's, Jax, Café Cordiale*, and *Vitello's*, Mike also became Merv Griffin's favorite pianist while playing at the "late" Mr. Griffin's legendary "*Coconut Club*" in Beverly Hills. Touring many music festivals on the West Coast, in 2004, Mike's band won the *Best Jazz Fusion Artist of the Year* at the Long Beach Jazz Festival. Recently settling in South Florida, Mike plays solo piano and performs with many bands at hotels and clubs throughout the area, as he continues to travel and perform in many of the best, world-class Jazz Venues in Los Angeles, Vancouver, Seattle, Hawaii, Boston, New Orleans and New York.

Mike is currently developing a new website, while composing scores for various independent film projects. He is working on a new solo piano CD in his private recording studio and co-writing, arranging and producing a CD with singer/songwriter/performing artist, nolia blue.
