MATERIALS LIST

*in addition to the list below, please feel free to bring any materials that you enjoy using except chalky pastels.

DRAWING MATERIALS:

Charcoal in various sizes, shapes

Graphite pencils

Caran'dach Crayons

White Steadler Eraser & Kneaded Eraser

Magic Markers different widths

9X12 Sketch Pad for notes and studies

Brushes that are your favorites

2" & 1" or larger Acrylic brush or house painters brushes

Plaster trowel 2- 3" or larger

Small roller (soft print roller is best)

Old Credit Cards that bend slightly

Printing Materials: Anything that you can print with; such as, bubble wrap, etc.

Tracing Paper

PAINTS:

Acrylic Paints are the easiest to use for this class because of the dry time, but you could work with the paints that you have knowing that the results will be slightly different. OR, you could just continue using just your drawing materials.

Black & White (Rose, Cadmium Yellow, Phtaylo Blue - Plus any color that you like)

Containers for water

Mediums if needed to extend or quicken drying times

Palette

SUPPORT:

Drawing Board larger than the paper that you bring.

4 Clips for your paper

18" x 24" (or larger) Drawing Paper

18" x 24" (or larger) Canvas or Watercolor Paper depending upon the medium you will be using

REFERENCE MATERIALS:

Bring anything to inspire you: An object like a shell, photos, poems, A title of a song.

Please bring anything that you enjoy looking at or holds memories for you.
