



The Stuart Segal Photography Scholarship Application Form

The Stuart Segal scholarship is dedicated to aiding aspiring photography students for whom attending class would otherwise be financially challenging. The scholarship will pay up to \$280 in tuition fees for any photography course offered via the VBMA's Museum Art School. The recipient may choose to enroll in one of the photography classes offered during the Winter and the Summer at the school.

To apply, complete the information below and submit your application to Christina Barber, Museum Art School Manager, at cbarber@vbmuseum.org, no later than two weeks after registration begins (see dates below). The scholarship must be used during the active term. Recipients will be notified via email and must confirm their registration within a week of notification.

Criteria for eligibility: The applicant must be a first-time participant in the class selected to qualify for this scholarship. The applicant must also need financial assistance to cover the cost of the tuition. If the applicant is a Veteran as defined by statute 38 U.S.C. § 101(2) p OR qualifies for financial aid programs such as Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), among other, they may apply.
