

WATERCOLOR EXPLORATIONS

Beginner and intermediate levels

This course will serve as an explorative introduction to the art of watercolor. Students will explore a variety of basic watercolor techniques, color relationships, and artistic expression with the watercolor medium. Emphasis will be placed on color, composition, shape, and enjoying the nuances of watercolor.

Recommended SUPPLY LIST for students to bring to class:

Watercolor paper: 140 lb. size 12x16

Watercolor tin that contains several squares or ovals of color

Watercolor "wash" brush, a medium-sized 1 ½ in. wide

Watercolor wash brush flat tip ½ in. wide

Pointed watercolor brush

Small pointed watercolor brush

Plastic cup for water

Flat white "butchers tray" or several white plastic dishes for mixing colors

Paper towels

#2 pencil

Black ultra-fine sharpie
